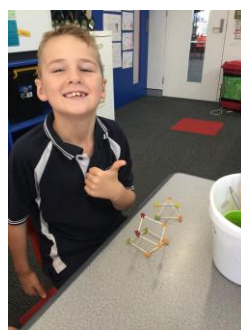


# Grade 2 News!
