2015 HOT LUNCH PROGRAM:

The hot lunch program starts next Wednesday, 22nd July and runs each Wednesday until the end of term.

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS:-

On Wednesday mornings, children bring their order form to their grade and drop it into a special box near the classroom doorway. Every child **MUST** have a separate form, however the oldest child in the family can have the total for their siblings in their order bag.

Please use a named zip lock bag which will be returned for future use. Change can be given - but correct amount is preferred. There are no 'shop' lunches available on Wednesdays during term three.

The second issue of bookclub for term two has been handed out to students. Of all the orders received the school receives **20%** to spend on books and resources through Scholastic!

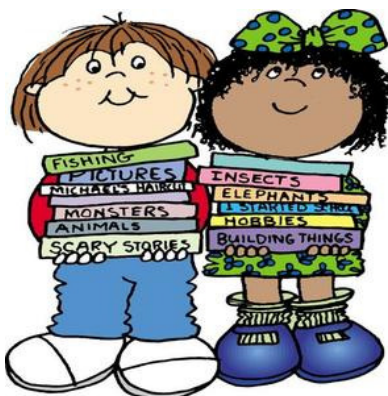
Issue 4 Bookclub Orders and payment (or payment details) are due back to the office by:
